Councils usually police their box junctions with cameras, with transgressors automatically hit with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN). In most places the fine could be as much as £70, although in London - where box junctions are most common - the penalty stands at £130. However, if paid within 14 days the fine is halved to £65.
