With a capacity of 272 MWp, the park is made up of two contiguous solar plants -- the Rio Maior Solar Power Plant (204 MWp) and the Torre Bela Solar Power Plant (68 MWp) -- both wholly owned by Neoen.

Called the Sophia Photovoltaic Solar Park, it aims to "reconcile renewable energy production with environmental enhancement of the territory and lasting benefits for local communities", according...

With a capacity of 272 MWp, the Portuguese park is composed of two contiguous solar farms, Rio Maior Solar Farm (204 MWp) and Torre Bela Solar Farm (68 MWp), both fully owned by Neoen.

In partnership with EDP Renovüveis, CJR Renewables was responsible for the construction of the Cerca solar park in Portugal, one of the largest projects in Europe.
