Within this period, the under-performing solar panels will be replaced, or the owner gets compensated for the associated losses. On the other hand, solar inverters are more complex and hence have shorter warranty periods of 5 to 12 years. However, as solar inverters are easily accessible, they can be swapped out when required.

If you have a string inverter system, extending your SolarEdge warranty may be a smart investment. Most standard string inverter warranties last between 5 and 12 years, and inverter failure during this period can result in complete system shutdown, leading to lost solar production and unexpected costs.
