Connect the battery cable accessory to one end of the battery port on the rear panel of the UPS and connect the other end to any battery port on the rear panel of the EBC.

The connection of auxiliary contacts is dependent on the number of battery breakers supported by the UPS. In

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the examples below two banks of battery breakers are supported.

Route the battery temperature sensor cables through the conduit box to the UPS. Disconnect the cables from J2-1 and J2-2 and connect the battery temperature sensor.

UPS Input: The UPS input is where the utility power is connected to the UPS. This connection allows the UPS to monitor the utility power and switch to battery power when necessary.
